

## Registration & Fees

Register as soon as possible. There are two cheques required for registration, a \$50 non-refundable registration fee and a \$50 text/materials deposit. Please make all cheques payable to PSD 70. The registration cheques will be cashed upon registration and the deposit cheque returned to the student **upon completion of the course and return of all course materials. Students not completing the course will have the deposit cheque cashed.**

**Note:** adult students the non-refundable course registration fee is

**\$350 (5 Credits) or \$210 (3 Credits)**

The signed registration form, a copy of the Birth Certificate along with the two cheques are to be dropped off at Outreach.

\* **these courses require that students register for diploma examinations using their myPass and are only for students needing to REPEAT the course. NO first timers.**

## Student Workload and Attendance

Since high school credit courses are compressed into a short period of time (June 30 – July 22), students must be prepared to spend two to three hours per day on site.

The assisted independent study program is intended for those students needing to REPEAT a course to improve a grade and NOT to take the course for the FIRST TIME.

Exceptions are the 1 credit CTS, Work Experience, CALM/HCS 3000, Aboriginal Studies, World Geography & Forensic Sciences.

It is recommended that students only enroll in only one class that they require upgrading in.

Students should not plan holidays during the Summer School period. Student absenteeism could lead to failure and loss of credits.

Summer school registrations start May 1 and materials can be picked up at that time. Students who wish to take a course for the first time should register and start at this time.

***Note: all course work must be completed by Friday, July 21 and examinations by Saturday, July 22, 2017***
