

SCHOLARSHIP WEBSITES BY MONTH:

September:

Alberta Blue Cross 50th Anniversary Scholarship Fund (supports 65 Scholarships in total) –These scholarships are awarded to Alberta students on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. Most awards are administered directly through the accredited post-secondary institutions listed. See specific post-secondary institution links on website for complete details.

Value ranges from \$750 - \$1500, numbers available vary by institution.

Deadline varies by institution

Alberta Blue Cross Scholarships for Aboriginal Students - Aboriginal applicants must have just completed their final year of high school and be entering into their first year of post-secondary studies at an accredited Alberta post-secondary institute. See website for complete details.

Value ranges from \$375 - \$1500 with three scholarships awarded per year.

Deadline – January 15, 2019.

Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops Ltd. Achievement Award - Applicants must be children of co-operative members of gas utilities within the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops, as well as, children or landowners who are serviced by gas member towns, villages, counties, or bands (memberships must have been in place at least one full year). Children of active members of the Provincial Federation Board are NOT eligible. See website for complete details.

Value Four \$1000 awards will be granted annually.

The Earl and Countess of Wessex Edmonton 2001 World Championships in Athletics Scholarships – Given to the top track and Field male and female Grade 12 student. Recipients will be selected based on their proven athletic abilities. See website for complete details.

Value of \$3,000 with 2 scholarships awarded.

University of Toronto National Scholarship- Grade 12 students with superior academic performance, original and creative thought, and exceptional achievement in a broad context. See website for complete details.

Value Scholarship includes tuition and incidental fees for four year of undergraduate study, residence support in first year, and will include an additional, renewable monetary award.

Excellence in Ag 4-H Scholarship - Grade 12 students that are 4-H members and who are planning to enroll in post-secondary education in an agriculture or agri-business related discipline. See website for complete details.

Value up to \$20,000, with up to \$5000 per year paid out over a max of four years.

Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada Student Aid Program - The recipient must be a son, daughter, or ward of a person whose principal income is derived from the pipeline construction industry in Canada and whose employer is a member of the Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada. Applicant must provide proof of full-time enrollment in a program leading to a diploma or degree at a recognized Canadian college or university. See website for complete details.

Loran Award – Grade 12 students with an academic average above 85%. Students must be well rounded and demonstrate character, promise of leadership, and strong commitment to service in their community. See website for complete details.

Value of up to \$100,000 over four years with approximately 30 scholarships awarded. The Loran Scholars Foundation will also grant 104 finalist and provincial awards (\$2,000 or \$5,000 each) to promising candidates.

Deadline - Three students can be sponsored by the school with an application deadline of mid-October. Other students can be direct pool applicants with a deadline of late October.

TD Canada Trust Scholarships for Community Leadership - Scholarships are open to grade 12 students who have demonstrated outstanding community leadership and obtain a minimum average of 75%. See website for complete details.

Value of up to \$70,000 and includes: up to \$10,000 for tuition per year and \$7,500 a year toward living expenses, an offer of paid summer employment, mentorship opportunities, invitations to annual gatherings, networking opportunities and events.

Deadline – Opens September 1.

Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs - Grade 12 students planning to enter university in the fall to pursue a bachelor's degree. Students who demonstrate financial need (a combined income of \$65,000 or less), display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, a minimum grade percentage of 65%, and is a Canadian citizen. Value 160 students will receive \$5,000; and 10 students will receive \$10,000.
