

# SCHOLARSHIP WEBSITES BY MONTH:

## September:

**Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada Student Aid Program** - The recipient must be a son, daughter, or ward of a person whose principal income is derived from the pipeline construction industry in Canada and whose employer is a member of the Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada. Applicant must provide proof of full-time enrollment in a program leading to a diploma or degree at a recognized Canadian college or university. See website for complete details.

**Value** not specified.

**Deadline** - October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

**Loran Award** – Grade 12 students with an academic average above 85%. Students must be well rounded and demonstrate character, promise of leadership, and strong commitment to service in their community. See website for complete details.

**Value** of up to \$100,000 over four years with approximately 30 scholarships awarded. The Loran Scholars Foundation will also grant 94 finalist and provincial awards (\$2,000 or \$3,000 each) to promising candidates.

**Deadline** - Three students can be sponsored by the school with an application deadline of mid-October. Other students can be direct pool applicants with a deadline of late October.

**University of Toronto National Book Award and Scholarship** - Grade 12 students with superior academic performance, original and creative thought, and exceptional achievement in a broad context. See website for complete details.

**Value** Scholarship includes tuition and incidental fees for four year of undergraduate study, residence support in first year, and will include an additional, renewable monetary award.

**Deadline** - the beginning of October.

**The Earl and Countess of Wessex Edmonton 2001 World Championships in Athletics Scholarships** – Given to the top track and Field male and female Grade 12 student. Recipients will be selected based on their proven athletic abilities. See website for complete details.

**Value** of \$3,000 with 2 scholarships awarded.

**Deadline** - October 1.

**TD 4-H Scholarship** - Grade 12 students that are 4-H members and who are planning to enroll in post-secondary education in an agriculture or agri-business related discipline. See website for complete details.

**Value** \$2,000 each with ten scholarships awarded.

**TD Canada Trust Scholarships for Community Leadership** - Scholarships are open to grade 12 students who have demonstrated outstanding community leadership and obtain a minimum average of 75%. See website for complete details.

**Value** of up to \$70,000 and includes: up to \$10,000 for tuition per year and \$7,500 a year toward living expenses, an offer of paid summer employment, mentorship opportunities, invitations to annual gatherings, networking opportunities and events.

**Alberta Blue Cross Scholarships for Aboriginal Students** - Aboriginal applicants must have just completed their final year of high school and be entering into their first year of post-secondary studies at an accredited Alberta post-secondary institute. See website for complete details.
