

## **Deadlines in October:**

**University of Alberta Admissions-based scholarship** – Graduating grade 12 students applying for an undergraduate degree to University of Alberta. No application needed- based on your admissions.

Possible scholarships:

- **Gold Standard Scholarship** - top 5% of students in each faculty receive up to \$6,000
- **Indigenous Entrance Scholarship** – Self-declaring First Nations, Metis or Inuit with an average of 80%+ may receive \$1,500
- **International Achievement Scholarship** – Students with superior academics attending high school in Canada on a study permit may receive a scholarship up to \$9,000 payable over four years.

**Deadline:** no deadline- just through your admissions

**Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops Ltd. Achievement Award** - Applicants must be children of co-operative members of gas utilities within the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops, as well as, children or landowners who are serviced by gas member towns, villages, counties, or bands (memberships must have been in place at least one full year). Children of active members of the Provincial Federation Board are NOT eligible. See website for complete details.

**Value** Four \$1000 awards will be granted annually.

**Value** of \$3,000 with 2 scholarships awarded.

**Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada Student Aid Program** - The recipient must be a son, daughter, or ward of a person whose principal income is derived from the pipeline construction industry in Canada and whose employer is a member of the Pipe Line Contractors Association of Canada. Applicant must provide proof of full-time enrollment in a program leading to a diploma or degree at a recognized Canadian college or university. See website for complete details.

**Excellence in Ag 4-H Scholarship** - Grade 12 students that are 4-H members and who are planning to enroll in post-secondary education in an agriculture or agri-business related discipline. See website for complete details.

**Value** up to \$20,000, with up to \$5000 per year paid out over a max of four years.

**Deadline** – Oct 15

**Loran Award** – Grade 12 students with an academic average above 85%. Students must be well rounded and demonstrate character, promise of leadership, and strong commitment to service in their community. See website for complete details.

**Value** of up to \$100,000 over four years with approximately 30 scholarships awarded. The Loran Scholars Foundation will also grant 104 finalist and provincial awards (\$2,000 or \$5,000 each) to promising candidates.

**Deadline** - Three students can be sponsored by the school with an application deadline of mid-October. Other students can be direct pool applicants with a deadline of late October.

**Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs-** Grade 12 students planning to enter university in the fall to pursue a bachelor’s degree. Students who demonstrate financial need (a combined income of \$65,000 or less), display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, a minimum grade percentage of 65%, and is a Canadian citizen. **Value** 160 students will receive \$5,000; and 10 students will receive \$10,000.

### **Deadlines in November:**

**TD Canada Trust Scholarships for Community Leadership** - Scholarships are open to grade 12 students who have demonstrated outstanding community leadership and obtain a minimum average of 75%. See website for complete details.

**Value** of up to \$70,000 and includes: up to \$10,000 for tuition per year and \$7,500 a year toward living expenses, an offer of paid summer employment, mentorship opportunities, invitations to annual gatherings, networking opportunities and events.

**Deadline** – November 15, 2019

**High School Apprenticeship Scholarship/Bright Future** – Scholarship recognizing the accomplishments of high school students completing the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) or the Career and Technology Studies pathway.
